Troon Harrison's thirty-six books are published in seven languages, including ones she cannot read such as Arabic, Norwegian, and Portuguese!

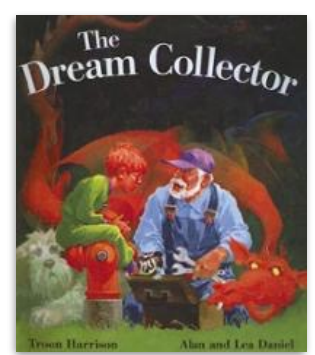
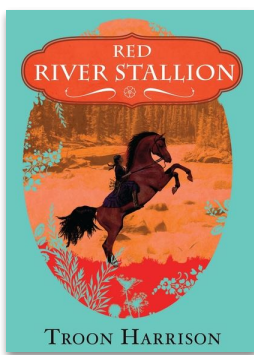
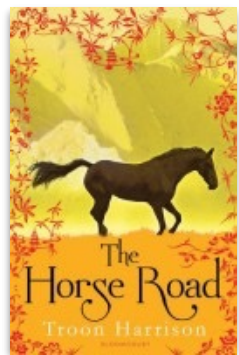
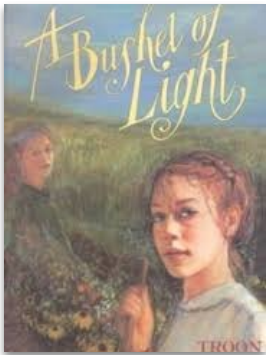
Her work has been animated for YTV, and translated into Braille. She enjoys the challenge of writing for different age groups, and has success with picture books, junior chapter books, and YA novels.

Troon's books have been honored with many distinctions including shortlists for the Manitoba Young Readers Choice Award 2015 (for *Red River Stallion*), and the Panda Award 2013 in China (for *The Horse Road*). A translation of her picture book, *Frost Flyer*, won the Youth Jury Prize 2014 in Austria.
